How to make your own

Doughnut Dreamcatchers

(you need: ring doughnuts, boho feathers printed on card / your own feathers drawn on card / real feathers, thin ribbon or string, small plastic beads, scissors, big eyed needle, colouring pens / felt tips

- 1. Colour in (optional) and roughly cut out the feather shapes in pairs (image one) dont worry about being too neat!
- 2. glue the back of the twin feather shapes.
- 3.fold the shapes down the middle and press firmly together(image 3)
- 4. trim the excess white card from your folded feather shapes.
- 5. measure two 40cm lengths of ribbon and tie a small bead 15cm up each of them. Also measure a 20cm piece of ribbon. Tie your feather shapes to the ends of all three ribbons (image 5)
- 6. Thread one of the long ribbon pieces right through the side of the ring doughnut using a big eyed needle. pull through until the bead touches the doughnut(image 6)
- 7. repeat step 6 with the other long piece of ribbon, but this time use another threading angle (image 7)
- 8. Now thread the short piece of ribbon right trhough the doughnut centrally between the two previous ribbons and secure at the top with a bead (image 8)
- 9. Tie together the ribbon ends at the top and hang your dreamcatcher somewhere to be admired by everyone! Good job! now have a great day ahead x
